

Simple Block Quilts

Cut (36) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks. Sew them together in rows of six squares each. Sew the rows together.

Cut out your batting.

Lay batting and quilt top on top of the backing fabric.

Trim an extra two inches all around the quilt top.

Fold the extra trim toward the center. Then fold again. The second fold should overlap the front of the quilt.

Sew left side, right side, and then the top and bottom of binding to the quilt top.

Your finished quilt will measure 36" X 36".

You can do the same with 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; six to a row. Your finished quilt will measure 48" X 48".

You can do the same with 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; six to a row. Your finished quilt will measure 60" X 60".

Suggestions to Finish Quilt

Hand tie top of quilt

Stitch in the ditch

Free motion

Hand stitch

It doesn't matter which option you choose, just make sure the top is stable.
